NATIVE FORESTRY TEAM WINS SUSTAINABLE ENVIRONMENT AWARD

Recognising their commitment to deliver sustainable resources the Forest Products Team of the Department of Environment & Resource Management (DERM) have won an award for their efforts to obtain and maintain long-term chain of custody certification for Queensland's native forests.
